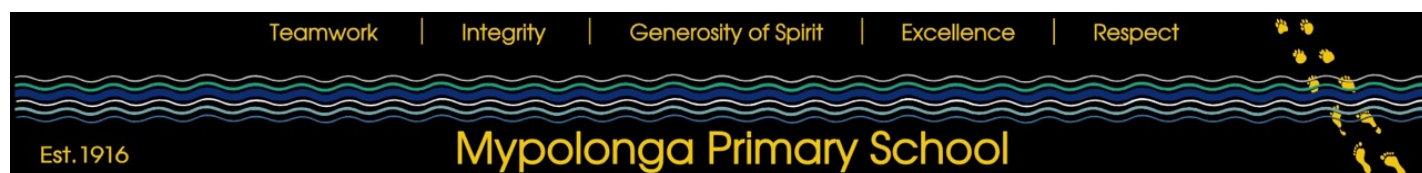
### NAPLAN Online Readiness Test
