I received this email last week from the University of Osaka in Japan, who have been commissioned to write the Financial Literacy curriculum for Japan. Exciting times!

'Dear Rita

I have been assisting the research project of Financial Literacy for the last two years for Professor Suzuki and Professor Ohmoto. They coordinate this project at Osaka Kyoiku University in Japan.

I am writing this letter to request to visit your school 'Mypolonga Primary School'. Mypolonga Primary School is one of the active Money Smart participating primary schools according to the website (Enterprise School Shop).

Please see the attached document which I translated; the 'Research Project Proposal': Professor Suzuki initially wrote this in Japanese for research funding approval.

It would be a great honour for us to visit your school to see the School Shop and interview the students and teachers. Our research trip will take place from 19th of February on Wednesday to the 22nd of February on Saturday in 2020. We are highly interested in your 'School Shop'. (If you run any other money smart activities, we would like to view as well.)

Japanese Curriculum is currently asked to revise rapidly to meet the advanced Western Education standard by the Japanese Government (The Ministry of Education). Therefore, we believe this research of Money Smart participating school will assist the development of future Japanese Curriculum.

We look forward to your response and hope to be able to start the preparations as soon as possible.
