- . There is a \$5.00 per term fee to attend our Tiny Tigers.
- . Children aged newborn to age 5 are welcome to attend.
- . Shoes must be worn at all times.
- . While Tiny Tigers is running, each parent/ caregiver has the duty of care for their own child/children.
- . The back playground (near the staff carpark) may be used by Tiny Tigers children under adult supervision.

Our Tiny Tigers Coordinator plans fun and educational activities for the Tiny Tigers children. - . Please sign in on your arrival and sign out on your departure.
- . Emergency and evacuation procedures are sign posted around the school.
- . The disabled toilet houses a baby change table. Please dispose of nappies in the big green bin located along North Bokara Road.
- . If you intend sending your child/ren to Mypolonga Primary School, we suggest that you complete a future student information form so we can include your child on our database. Please see Necia in the office for further details.
- . We kindly ask that your child/ren have a named water bottle with them.

- . We are a SunSmart school so the wearing of hats whilst outside during Terms 1, 3 and 4 is essential.
- . Tiny Tigers is an affiliated body of the school's Governing Council and there is a Tiny Tigers' representative who tables a report at Governing Council meetings twice a term.
- . To ensure the sustainability of Tiny Tigers, it is important to identify new births and families moving into the Mypolonga district. If you are aware of anyone meeting this criteria, please let us know!
- . You may like to bring your own small toys if your baby is in the 'mouthing' stage.

To provide a COVID-19 safe environment, it is a requirement that:

- . **Adults wear masks at all times.**
- . **Please sign in/out using the Tiny Tigers sign in book located in the Library.**
- . **Adults maintain physical distancing of at least 1.5 metres apart.**
- . **Avoid close contact activities.**
- . **Please wash your hands or use hand sanitiser on arrival.**
- . **Attendees may be asked to leave if they show any signs or symptoms of any illness.**
- . **If your child or someone living with you is ill or has symptoms, please stay home.**
- . **Please refrain from sharing food.**
