

Old Scholar News

CONGRATULATIONS to past student Benjamin Peterson (2018) who recently finished his time in Little Athletics in fine style, being named State U17 Male Champion at the recent State Little Athletics Awards.

In his final season, Benjamin won medals at the three State athletics events, starting with 1 gold and 1 silver at the State Relay Championships.

Benjamin won the silver medal at the State Combined Event - a test of all-round athletic ability in the form of a modified heptathlon,

consisting of 100m hurdles, 100m sprint, 800m, long jump, high jump, discus and javelin. This was followed by 4 gold medals (100m, high jump, long jump & triple jump) and 1 silver (400m) at his final State Individual Championships. Benjamin also recorded 39 personal best performances and set 15 centre records across the season. Well done Benjamin!
