# Student Free Day Learning

Last Tuesday, our staff attended training at the Tailem Bend Primary School to work with other schools from our partnership focussing on how we can improve our students learning in Maths. Staff were challenged in looking at our student data to see where each of them were placed to move them on, as well as learning in the first 3 concepts of the Big Ideas in Number. Below is some information on these concepts, helping you to assist your children with these ideas.

Trusting the Count

Students need a deep understanding of the numbers 0 to 10 by the end of their first year in school. Students who trust the count:

- $\cdot$  can represent the numbers 0 to 10 and beyond in multiple ways and in a range of contexts
- · can recognise collections of numbers without counting one by one
- $\cdot$  use comparative language related to collections and quantities.

Place Value

By the end of Year 2, students need a deep understanding of the place value number naming pattern.

Students who understand place value can:

- · knowing 10 of these is 1 of those
- $\cdot$  make connections between amounts and a variety of representations
- · count large collections by 2s, 5s and 10s and recognise them as countable units
- · model (using concrete materials), name and record 2-digit numbers; then 3-digit numbers and explain place value to their peers and teacher
- $\cdot$  demonstrate their knowledge of place value by comparing, ordering, counting and renaming when talking about practical everyday problems.

Multiplicative Thinking

**By the end of Year 4**, students need to be able to think about multiplication in a range of ways that show how multiplication and division are related.

Students with multiplicative thinking can:

- $\cdot$  hold the number in each group, the number of groups and the total amount in their minds at the same time
- $\cdot$  picture multiplication as an array, region or area model
- · recognise and use equal groups in rows and columns
- · understand that collections can be rearranged while the quantity stays the same.

### Save the date - Whole School Excursion and Disco

Earlier in the year, we received a Wellbeing Boost Grant from the Federal Government that has allowed us to plan ways in which we can assist student wellbeing. One of the actions we have decided to take is to plan a whole school excursion. On Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October 2023, all students will be bussed to Adelaide for a session at AFL Max, before returning to the Mypolonga Combined Sports' Club for the school disco, followed by the disco tea. We look forward to celebrating this occasion with all students and to you joining us at the end of the disco for tea!

They designed bag tags and a card with their special messages inside.




# Father's Day 2023
