## What is bullying?

Bullying is a pattern of repeated physical, verbal, psychological, or social aggression that is directed towards a specific student by someone with more power and is intended to cause harm, distress and create fear. It can be visible and clear to all, or it can be invisible and insidious.

## **Bullying and Harassment Intervention Processes**

Step 1	Step 2	Step 3
<ul> <li>Ask them to stop</li> <li>Walk away</li> <li>If it is appropriate tell them it is upsetting you.</li> <li>Don't retaliate</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Tell the teacher or school counsellor</li> <li>Tell a trusted adult who will advocate for you</li> <li>The teacher /school counsellor will record the harassment and work with the victim and the perpetrator to resolve the problem.</li> </ul>	If the conflict is not resolved or there are repeated offences:  • Work through school's Student Behaviour Management processes.  • Contact bully's parents  • At the discretion of the Principal or School Counsellor continued bullying and harassment will result in suspension.
